**Minutes of the meeting**

**1. Academic Updates:**

- a. The CBSE board results for class 10<sup>th</sup> and 12<sup>th</sup> for the year 2022 were shared with the members.
- b. All the term 1 events like Gurupornima celebration, Independence Day, 15th Foundation Day , Achievers Day details were also shared with the members.
- c. GGIS Achievements :
  - i. **Interschool Sports Events :**
    1. Athletics: District level - Sairaj of class IXA – Bronze in Shot Put, Bronze in Relay of Junior girls.
    2. Smit Sorte won gold in 33 West Zone National Championship 2022 – 400m race and will represent Maharashtra for the National level meet.
    3. Women's National ranking Tournament in archery - Aarya Prasad of class X secured gold.
    4. State Level Taekwondo Championship - Bronze Medal for Arya Agarwal (Class I) and Arushi Upadhye Class VIII.
    5. In Interschool speech competition organized by Kalyani School – Devika Chandran of Class 12 secured the 3<sup>rd</sup> position.
    6. Humanitarian works Inter School Social Science Debate Competition held at Delhi public school Pune- GGIS won the first prize as an interjector - Sudhanwa Joshi of Grade XI
    7. International Drawing Competition organised by Government of India - Advika Ghokale (Class 10)-3<sup>rd</sup> Prize and Ananya Ahirao (Class 8)-4<sup>th</sup> Prizes.
  - ii. **Dance competition** by Akhil Bhartiya Sanskruti Sangha in partnership with UNESCO – GGIs won first prize for senior section and third prize for junior section. National Level Inter School Dance Olympic - 1st Prize- Senior Category and 2nd prize - Junior Category in folk dance.

3. **Fees for the academic year 2023-2024:** The Principal presented the fee structure for the next two consecutive years and proposed a fee structure for 2023-2024 and 2024-2025 with an increase of 15% on the current fee structure for all the classes.

Principal Ma'am explained the new initiatives being taken up by the school to improve the teaching learning processes that involve additional expenses.

1. Inclusion of robotics and coding from Grade 6<sup>th</sup> onwards.
2. Inclusion of skill programs for Grade 9<sup>th</sup> and 10<sup>th</sup>. Also home science for Grade 6<sup>th</sup> to 8<sup>th</sup>.
3. Organizing Career Cell program for students.
4. Class presentation will be conducted in hired premises in a professional form.
5. Trainings will be given to teachers to take up IB mode of curriculum in primary section for continuous improvement to achieve further excellence.
6. The school has a no tuition policy for which we need to put in extra efforts like bridging and enrichment classes.
7. As the school has completed 15 years, the infrastructure maintenance has also increased.
