### Academic Updates from April – June 2024

Principal Ms. Dhruvi Bhatia presented a comprehensive report covering the academic updates from April to June 2024, including an analysis of school timings for classes 1 to 4, overall academic performance, and top performers in Class X and Class XII. The report highlighted the school's excellent performance with a 100% pass rate and high distinctions. Key initiatives such as Ankuram results, teachers' preparedness, learning outcomes, assessments, and home visits were discussed. Additionally, new initiatives for 2024-25 include first aid training, a continued ban on packet food, community service, class reunions, and the introduction of NCC.

### Insights from Bharti Ma'am, Director Principal:

Director Principal Ms. Bharti Bhagwani highlighted the advantages of various school initiatives and programs, emphasizing the necessity of periodic learning and assessments. She discussed ongoing and upcoming initiatives aimed at supporting students' academic and career development, and stressed the importance of home visits and community service.

Additionally, she reiterated the importance of community service in fostering students' holistic development and sense of civic duty.
