7. The Executive Committee suggested preparing a list of key focus areas where each EC member can contribute their expertise towards the school's continuous improvement and development.

9. One of the Executive Committee members, an alumnus of PCCOE, will facilitate collaboration between the school and PCCOE for academic and institutional development.

11. The Health and Physical Education (HPE) periods for Classes IX and X should be scheduled during the morning hours, considering the excessive heat experienced during afternoon hours.
12. A structured programme should be introduced to strengthen and promote Hindi reading habits among students.
